The Pastor's <u>Job</u> — <u>Shepherd</u> The <u>Flock</u>.

So I exhort <u>the elders among you</u>, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed: <u>shepherd the flock of God that is among you</u>,... 1 Peter 5:1–2 (ESV)

How can we misunderstand spiritual leadership?

• Pastor as Entertainer, CEO or Spiritual Butler.

Why is spiritual leadership called shepherding?

- 1. Sheep get <u>lost</u>. They need a shepherd to <u>look</u> for <u>them</u>.
- 2. Sheep are easily <u>led astray</u>. They need a shepherd so they are <u>not deceived</u>.
- 3. Sheep need good <u>food</u> and <u>water</u>. They need a shepherd to <u>feed</u> <u>them</u>.
- 4. Sheep are <u>defenseless</u>. They need a shepherd for <u>protection</u>.

Who created the <u>shepherding</u> model of church <u>leadership</u>?

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. Psalm 23:1 (ESV)

<u>I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep</u>. John 10:11 (ESV)

The shepherding of leaders in the church is an <u>extension</u> of <u>God's</u> <u>shepherding</u> in my life.

<u>You led your people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron</u>. Psalm 77:20 (ESV)

The Pastor's **Pitfalls**.

The weak you have not strengthened, the sick you have not healed, the injured you have not bound up, the strayed you have not brought back, the lost you have not sought, and with force and harshness you have ruled them....Therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the Lord: As I live, declares the Lord God, surely because my sheep have become a prey, and my sheep have become food for all the wild beasts, since there was no shepherd, and because my shepherds have not searched for my sheep, but the shepherds have fed themselves, and have not fed my sheep, therefore, you shepherds,...I am against the shepherds, and I will require my sheep at their hand and put a stop to their feeding the sheep... Ezekiel 34:4, 7–10 (ESV)

1. Leading because I have to not because I want to.

...<u>not under compulsion, but willingly</u>, as God would have you;... 1 Peter 5:2 (ESV)

2. Serving to get from people not to give to people.

...not for shameful gain, but eagerly; 1 Peter 5:2 (ESV)

and constant friction among people who are depraved in mind and deprived of the truth, <u>imagining that godliness is a means of gain</u>. 1 Timothy 6:5 (ESV)

Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches. Galatians 6:6 (ESV)

<u>Who serves as a soldier at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard</u> <u>without eating any of its fruit? Or who tends a flock without getting some</u> <u>of the milk?</u> 1 Corinthians 9:7 (ESV)

3. Leading by <u>authority</u> instead of <u>example</u>.

not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. 1 Peter 5:3 (ESV)

I urge you, then, <u>be imitators of me</u>. 1 Corinthians 4:16 (ESV)

Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us. Philippians 3:17 (ESV)

The Pastor's <u>Reward</u> - The Unfading <u>Crown</u> Of <u>Glory</u>.

And <u>when the chief Shepherd appears</u>, you will receive the unfading <u>crown of glory</u>. 1 Peter 5:4 (ESV)

The <u>Congregation's</u> Job — <u>Submit</u> To Their <u>Leaders</u>.

Likewise, <u>you who are younger, be subject to the elders</u>... 1 Peter 5:5 (ESV)

- 1. Being subject means <u>affirming</u> and <u>supporting</u> the need for <u>local pastoral leadership</u> in my life.
- 2. Being subject means <u>seeking</u> my pastor's <u>teaching</u> and <u>counsel</u>.
- 3. Being subject means becoming a <u>member</u> of my local church.
- 4. Being subject means <u>participating</u> in my <u>local</u> <u>church programs</u> designed to care for my soul.

The Church's Attitude — <u>Humility</u>

...<u>Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another</u>, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." 1 Peter 5:5 (ESV)

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but <u>in humility count others</u> more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own <u>interests</u>, but also to the interests of others. Philippians 2:3–4 (ESV)
