Why is it important to participate in these activities now to prepare for eternity then?

Read Revelation 7:17; 21:4. Why is important to know God cares about us so much he will wipe away every tear?

What tears do you look forward to God wiping away?

Pause a few moments to consider what we, as believers, can do to encourage others to take advantage of the salvation Jesus offers. Based on your group discussion, what might be on your "To-Do" action list?
