Moralistic Therapeutic Deism

- Deism God exists but he is not involved in my everyday life.
- Therapeutic God wants me to be happy.
- Moralistic God wants me to be good.

What is the <u>true</u> gospel?

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 1 Corinthians 15:3–4 (ESV)

1. Where did we come from? — <u>Creation</u>

<u>In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.</u> Genesis 1:1 (ESV)

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever <u>you had</u> formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting <u>you are God</u>. Psalm 90:2 (ESV)

2. What has gone wrong? — Fall

as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; Romans 3:10 (ESV)

3. What is the solution? — Redemption

For <u>Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, 1 Peter 3:18 (ESV)</u>

4. What is the future? — Restoration

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away." The <u>Happy Meal</u> Gospel

In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, <u>if necessary</u>, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 1:6–7 (ESV)

Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. James 1:2–4 (ESV)

The **Prozac** Gospel


