How does God respond to sin?

He judges it.

He extends grace through Christ.

For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. 2 Corinthians 5:21 (ESV)


Conclusion - <u>Repent</u> of my sin; it is <u>killing</u> me. <u>Trust</u> in Christ.

The Human Condition

What is sin?

Sin is omission and commission.

Sin is deeper than actions.

Sin is ignoring God.

Sin is giving <u>affections</u> to something more than God.

Sin is not necessarily criminal.

Sin is breaking God's laws.

Sin is breaking the law of conscience.

But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. <u>For whatever</u> <u>does not proceed from faith is sin</u>. Romans 14:23 (ESV) What are some <u>sinful</u> responses to sin?

I'm the <u>exception</u> to the rule.

Blame Shifting

Partial Confession

Worldly Sorrow

I'm a Victim

Mere Confession

Sin is taking something good and <u>twisting</u> it <u>evil</u>.

Sin is finding our <u>identity</u> in something besides God's love through Jesus.

What is total depravity?

We are <u>totally</u> depraved but not <u>utterly</u> depraved.

What are some sinful views of sin?

Sin is just breaking rules.

Jesus died for my sin; it doesn't <u>matter</u> what I do.

God knows my heart; that is what counts.

You brood of vipers! How can you speak good, when you are evil? For <u>out of the abundance of the heart</u> the mouth speaks. Matthew 12:34 (ESV)

My sin doesn't matter; as long as nobody gets <u>hurt</u>.

It is only sinful if I get caught.

Is all sin equal?

Sin makes us equally guilty.

You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect. Matthew 5:48 (ESV)

For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become accountable for all of it. James 2:10 (ESV)

All sin is not equally <u>devastating</u> and equally <u>judged</u>.

Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness. James 3:1 (ESV)
