Am I grieving the Holy Spirit or repenting of sin?

And <u>do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God</u>, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Ephesians 4:30 (ESV)

For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death. 2 Corinthians 7:10 (ESV)

How can we <u>encourage</u> the Holy Spirit to show up in <u>power</u> at Faith EFC?



The Holy Spirit

And I will ask the Father, and <u>he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever,</u> John 14:16 (ESV)

Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. John 16:7 (ESV)

How does the Holy Spirit help us?

The Holy Spirit is the means of victory in our battle with sin.

And when he comes, <u>he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment:</u> John 16:8 (ESV)

The Holy Spirit <u>empowers</u> me to share <u>Christ</u>.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 (ESV)

Why don't I experience <u>more</u> of the Holy Spirit in my <u>life</u>?

Is Christ my <u>Savior</u> and <u>Lord</u>?

Am I <u>quenching</u> the spirit or wanting to be <u>controlled</u> by Him?

Do not quench the Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 5:19 (ESV)

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but <u>be filled with the Spirit</u>, Ephesians 5:18 (ESV)

For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. For to set the mind on the flesh is death. but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. Romans 8:5-11 (ESV)

The Holy Spirit <u>comforts</u> us in our <u>troubles</u>.

So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied. Acts 9:31 (ESV)

And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:7 (ESV)

The Holy Spirit produces relational harmony.

eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:3 (ESV)

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. 2 Corinthians 13:14 (ESV)

I have written something to the church, but Diotrephes, who likes to put himself first, does not acknowledge our authority. 3 John 9 (ESV)

The Holy Spirit is <u>Prozac</u> for the <u>depressed</u>.

For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. Romans 14:17 (ESV)

And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit, 1 Thessalonians 1:6 (ESV)
