As a door turns on its hinges, so does a sluggard on his bed. Proverbs 26:14 (ESV)

2. Am I trying to discern God's will?

Therefore do not be foolish, but <u>understand what the will of the Lord is</u>. Ephesians 5:17 (ESV)

- God's will is found in <u>assembling</u> all the <u>pieces</u> of the Bible, not from just <u>one</u> of the <u>pieces</u> in the Bible.
- What does it mean to be foolish?
- How do I discern God's <u>unrevealed</u> will for my life?

<u>Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.</u> <u>Psalm 37:4 (ESV)</u>

- Am I listening to those I <u>spiritually</u> respect?
- Don't substitute listening to your friends for listening to God?

3. Am I seeking to be <u>influenced</u> by the Spirit of God or the culture of the world?

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but <u>be filled with the</u> <u>Spirit</u>, <u>addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs</u>.

<u>Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise</u>, Ephesians 5:15 (ESV)

· God wants me to take time to reflect and plan my life.

What do I need to know about wise living?

- Human wisdom is about <u>enlarging</u> me. Biblical wisdom is about <u>enlarging</u> God.
- Biblical wisdom is not tied to <u>education</u> and <u>intellect</u> and is available to all who seek God.

Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and <u>you teach me wisdom in</u> <u>the secret heart</u>. Psalm 51:6 (ESV)

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. James 1:5 (ESV)

• Biblical wisdom is the ability to <u>apply</u> God's truth to <u>everyday</u> <u>life</u>.

- Be careful. <u>Everything</u> influences me.
- Let God influence me through music.
