- 3. **Read Ephesians 2:4-7.** Why is "but God" such good news?
- 4. Take a moment and personalize this passage. Fill in these blanks to remind you of what God has rescued you from.

- 7. Write down one or two tangible ways that you can live out your faith this week as a response to what God has done for us. Write down who, when, and how. How are these acts worship to God?

This week, go to a local coffee shop. After buying your drink, give the cashier a few extra dollars (5, 10, 20, you name it). Ask them to use that money to pay for the people who come in until it is all used up. Request that they do this without revealing who gave the gift. Find a seat in the coffee shop in view of the register and watch to see how people react. After seeing reactions, answer the following questions.



- How does giving this type of gift make you feel? Do you feel better when people know you gave them a gift or when they don't know you gave to them?
- What reactions surprised you the most as you watched (both good and bad)?
- How does giving this gift to others help you understand more of who God is?
