2. I am getting the gospel to others like someone did for me.

3. The <u>only way</u> people can know Jesus is if the church tells them.

how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly. When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit. This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel. Ephesians 3:3–6 (ESV)

A mystery is a fact about reality that can not be discovered by investigation and research but it needs to be supernaturally revealed by God.

4. It is a gift to serve in the church even in the most humbling ways.

Of this gospel I was made <u>a minister according to the gift of God's grace</u>, which was given me by the working of his power. Ephesians 3:7 (ESV)

5. The privilege of <u>serving</u> is the opposite of what I am <u>deserving</u>.

To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, Ephesians 3:8 (ESV)

6. The church has <u>cosmic</u> significance.

and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things, so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. Ephesians 3:9–10 (ESV)
