

John 17

Jesus prays for glory.

When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. John 17:1–2 (ESV)

<u>He is the radiance of the glory of God</u> and the exact imprint of his nature,... Hebrews 1:3 (ESV)

For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:6 (ESV)

Glory from <u>Authority</u>

<u>since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all</u> <u>whom you have given him</u>. And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. John 17:2–3 (ESV)

Jesus prays for his disciples.

"<u>I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the</u> world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you. For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. I am praying for them. <u>I am not</u> praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. John 17:6–10 (ESV)

> even as <u>he chose us in him before the foundation of the</u> world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love he predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, to the praise of <u>his glorious grace</u>, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. Ephesians 1:4–6 (ESV)
