Hell's punishments feel offensive because we don't <u>understand</u> the <u>seriousness</u> of sin.



Is Not Enough

Hell Defined

Hell - The place of eternal, conscious, just torment at the hand of Christ.

Hell Defended

Universalism - Taking <u>eternity</u> out of hell.

And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, <u>some to everlasting life</u>, and <u>some to shame and</u> <u>everlasting contempt</u>. Daniel 12:2 (ESV)

"Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels... And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." Matthew 25:41, 46 (ESV)

And whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, <u>either in this age or in the age to come</u>. Matthew 12:32 (ESV)

Annihilationism - Taking the <u>consciousness</u> out of punishment.

he also will drink the wine of God's wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. And the smoke of <u>their torment</u> <u>goes up forever and ever, and they have no rest, day or</u> <u>night</u>, these worshipers of the beast and its image, and whoever receives the mark of its name." Revelation 14:10– 11 (ESV)

They will suffer the punishment of <u>eternal destruction</u>, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might, 2 Thessalonians 1:9 (ESV)

and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and <u>they will be tormented day and night forever and ever</u>. Revelation 20:10 (ESV)

Hell's punishments are just responses to sinful choices.

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And <u>the dead were judged</u> by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. Revelation 20:12 (ESV)

Hell's punishments are <u>not</u> <u>enough</u> to atone for sin.
